## Sea Music Teacher's Pack

This teacher resource pack is for Key Stage 1 and Lower Key Stage 2 (but could be adapted for younger and older children). It is based on Sir Anthony Caro's 'Sea Music' sculpture which is located 100 metres from Poole Museum on Poole Quay. The activities encompass a variety of learning styles, so that all the children taking part can access them.

The activities focus on the subjects: English, art and design, music, design and technology and computing.

The activities also provide an excellent opportunity for children to develop both their critical thinking and speaking and listening skills. Links to the National Curriculum are shown in the section called National Curriculum Links.
